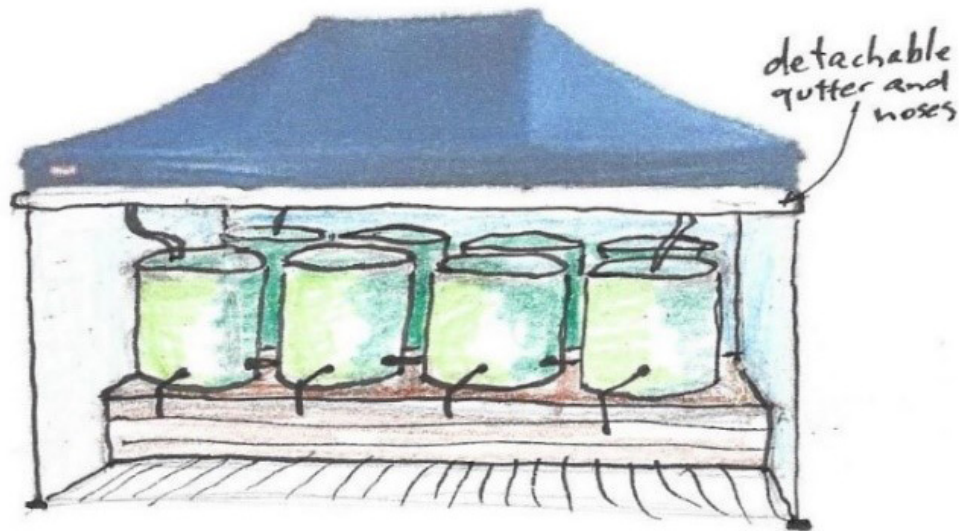




# GreenCo Waterstation

The **GreenCo Waterstation** is designed as a temporary facility. It provides an integrated safe water catchment and storage system, where large numbers of displaced people are located. Examples include refugee camps and temporary resettlement centres for those left homeless after natural disasters.

**GreenCo Waterstations** consist of portable, easily erected, highly durable waterproof marquees that can house a variety of configurations of up to ten 1,000 litre tanks. When strategically placed throughout camps and settlements, they would serve as focal points to meet drinking, cooking, personal hygiene and sanitation needs.

**GreenCo Waterstations** are designed to have the capacity to harvest their own rainwater, however, in low and unreliable rainfall areas the **GreenCo Waterstations** would best be placed so that they can be serviced regularly by water trucks (with a typical capacity of 12-13,000 litres) or tankers (with a typical capacity of up to 35,000 litres).

The heart of the system is our award-winning **GreenCo Water Pak Flat Tank™**, that is easily transportable to any location, and assembled (and disassembled) within minutes.

The design of **GreenCo Waterstations** being developed currently involves modifying standard commercially available 3x3m, 3.5x3.5m, 3x4.5m and/or 3x6m marquees. These marquees come in their own carrybags, and are easily erected on site. Depending on size and materials, each weighs around 25-35 kgs. Marquees are steel-framed, covered in tough waterproof fabric and come complete with guy ropes, anchors, etc. They have been strengthened to suit the harsh conditions in which the **GreenCo Waterstations** will typically operate, and modified to incorporate our unique attachable rainwater collection guttering and hoses.
